## Evergreen Oldtimer Tournament 2011

### Rules and Regulations

Revised : Jun 25 2011

1. Team managers must register their maximum 25 players in advance before the tournament, since the team rosters will be submitted to BCSA for record purpose. You may up-date your final roster at the Tournament Committee Desk prior to the start of your first game.
2. Manager must keep a complete team list, including names and birth year of the players.
3. Player born in the year **1971 or older** is eligible for "Over 40s"
4. Player born in the year **1961 or older** is eligible for "Over 50s"
5. Player cannot play for more than one team, no transfer of player from one division to another.
6. The first name is home team and will change tops if necessary.(Teams are advised to have 2 sets of Jerseys)

**7 . Any player ordered from the field of play by the referee for misconduct shall receive an automatic one game suspension and shall sit out his next scheduled game. Players dismissed for spitting, harassing, swearing etc OR any "INTENT TO INJURE" dismissal such as threatening, fighting, or physical/violent contact with another player or with any game official will result in more serious consequences. In cases of violent conduct or misconduct against a player or game official, the offending player shall be dismissed from the tournament and be reported to BC Soccer Association.**

8. There will be no overtime or penalty shots in round robin games. If the final game is a tie, the winner will be decided by Penalty shots.
9. Games : a. **2 x 35** minutes, no stop time  
b. Stop time, only if serious injury - Referee's decision

10. Points for game:

Win	6 points
Tie	3 points
Shut out	1 point (0-0 draw, shut out does not count)
Goal	1 point per goal, maximum to 3 points

**Maximum points per game – 10 points**

Tie breakers are determined in the following order:

- a. +/-Goal difference
- b. Total goals for
- c. Flip coin

11. Shoot out Rule : Penalty shot out - NO rebounds.

12. **For 40s : All teams have to play 3 preliminary games with the finalists ranked by total points. The top 4 Ranking teams will advance to 2<sup>nd</sup> round. The two highest ranking teams will go to the Championship final. The third and fourth ranking teams will play for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner-up.**

**For 50s : The teams separated into 2 groups. All teams in each group have to play 3 preliminary games with the finalists ranked by total points. The highest ranking team in each group will go to championship final and the second ranking team in each group will play the 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner-up.**

13. Any disputes must be raised and reported to referee in-charge at least 5 minutes before the final whistle of the game. BCCSF Tournament Committee will investigate the case and will make a decision before the game to be carried on. Otherwise all games will be considered final – no protests will be allowed.
14. Any fraud of game, i.e. by using non-registered or underage players will results as a game loss of 0-2.
15. This tournament is sanctioned with BCSA, if any player is under suspension in any formal league will not be allowed to play (i.e. BCCSF, Metro League, Richmond League, Spanish League and Italian League, etc.).
16. Each player's photo ID must be ready for identification upon request by Referee or Tournament Committee at any time.
17. Awards :
- a. The Champion Team of each division will be no charge for next year's tournament entry and will be awarded a trophy.
  - b. The 1<sup>st</sup> Runner-up team of both division will be charged half price for next year's tournament entry and will be awarded a trophy.
  - c. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner-up team of each division will save \$100 for next year tournament entry.
  - d. All other teams will be awarded souvenirs
